

KEEN STUDENTS SCHOOL

COURSE FACT SHEET 2004/2005

INTRODUCTION

The Keen Students School is a voluntary organisation, which was set up in January 1990 with the aim to contribute to the task of raising educational standards in the London Borough of Tower Hamlets. It focuses upon young people raising their academic and vocational aspirations and broadening their social and cultural experiences.

APPLICATION/ENROLMENT

Enrolment week will be held in the second week of September commencing Tuesday 7th September to Thursday 9th September 2004.

Students are asked to complete an application form and provide 1 passport size photograph. It is also compulsory for students to give their home telephone number and address and so will be asked to provide proof of address and a contact no. i.e. telephone bill.

It is important for students taking their final exams this year to provide their present school /College candidate number.

Classes start on Tuesday 14th September 2004 at 5:30pm.

A membership card will be issued to all students who have paid the full *non-refundable* administration fee. This membership card must be carried at all times.

Students are expected to bring their own exercise books and stationary. However the school will provide basic stationary in emergencies.

ADMINISTRATION FEES

The non-refundable administration fee is payable on enrolment and applies to all students.

Students are required to pay the fee when registering.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Students must be between 11-21 years of age, be studying for their **GCSE, A'LEVEL, GNVQ** or equivalent public examinations and either reside or study in the London Borough of Tower Hamlets.

The courses start in September 2004 and finish in June 2005. Safe transport is provided for young female members during the winter period, there is a nominal charge for this service.

TUTORS/TUITION

The school has experienced tutors catering for most curriculum subjects offering help on an individual basis as well as group tuition. There are also sessions geared for exam preparation. The school provides help with UCAS applications and careers advice.

BOOKS/RESOURCES

The school has up-to 34 computers for student use, printers, photocopiers and an updated reference library. Past and present examination papers and syllabuses' from all main exam boards are available.

EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

As well as offering academic support we also organise social activities such as Ice Skating, bowling and sports activities. Previous activities include residential trips to Egypt, France, Cornwall, Devon, North Wales and Scotland. Day trips included Alton Towers, Chessington and other theme parks.
