APPLICATION / ENROLMENT

Applicants will be asked to sit an entrance test in their intended subject(s) on enrolment. The test aims to assess the candidate's ability, will be of a basic standard and not last for more than twenty minutes.

Non-refundable administration fee(s) must be paid prior to attending classes.

A small deposit will be charged for books and materials issued to students during the course. Again payment must be received before you attend classes. This deposit is refundable on return of school materials in a reasonable condition.

Students are expected to bring their own exercise books, pens and pencils. The school will provide specialised equipment.

FEES

£100.00 first subject, £65.00 for every consecutive subjects thereafter – (Non-refundable)

£25.00 Examination fee per subject (Approx)

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Candidates must be over 16 and not be taking the same subjects at other institutions.
